at 6:30 pm**

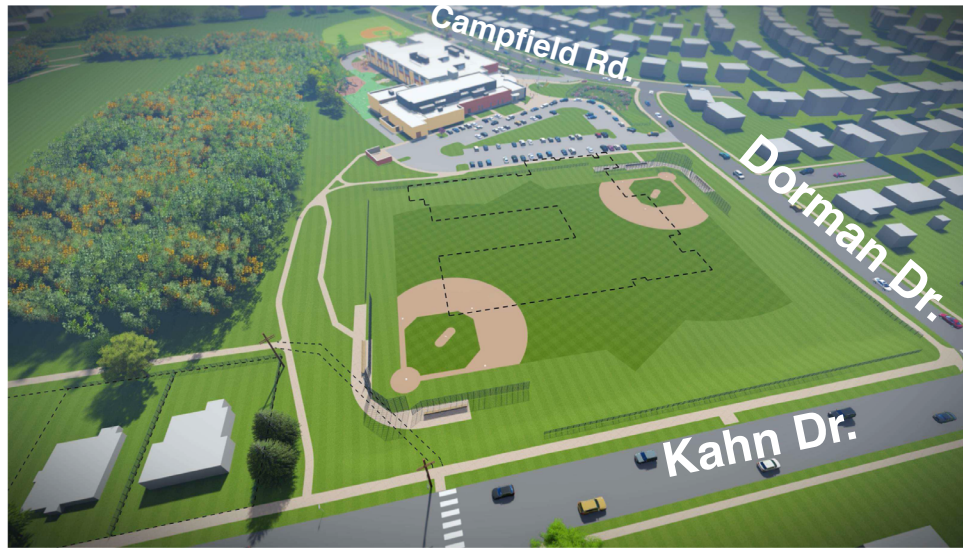

TWO BALL-FIELDS TO RELOCATE TO CORNER OF KAHN & DORMAN DRIVES



As most of you know from our previous updates, working with Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS) has not been an easy job. In negotiating with them we have not yet come to an agreement on the placement of the ball fields which they want to put on the corners of Kahn and Dorman. However, we are not done yet and as we continue the process, we will continue to keep you in the loop. Once again, however, we do want to make it clear that the WCA is absolutely in favor of the new school which will be a two story 21st century (tech ready) facility facing Campfield Rd. Our issue is about the placement of the ball fields. We need the BCPS to engage with us in thinking "outside the box" about how their plan can be improved for the sake of our community.

We had a meeting with BCPS on May 20th and again on June 29th. Unfortunately the June meeting did not go as we had hoped but we made it

very clear to them, both in that meeting and in our most recent position paper, that we will do whatever needs to be done in order to cause a change in their thinking. Our president Glen Charlow, V.P. Maxine Rubin, and resident and member of the WCA, Dr. D'Artegnon Tisdale have been the core negotiators. We want to make it possible for all of our members to be a part of this process but right now we are meeting virtually and only so many folks can be on at one time. We are waiting until we can get back into the library again as Covid precautions are being slowly lifted in the State of Maryland. When that happens, key players from BCPS will be invited to general membership meetings for you to interact with face to face.

Hopefully, we will meet with BCPS again before that and we'll share the results of that meeting with you as well.
